Tournament Rules

USBC Sanctioned Tournament

Participants must be a USBC member with current membership and in good standing of the USBC.

1. Tournament will consist of three games of 9-pin No tap, singles, by the following divisions:
Women: **Div A:** 55 yrs to 69 yrs, **Div B:** 70 yrs and older
Men: **Div A:** 55 yrs to 69 yrs, **Div B:** 70 yrs and older
2. Tournament shall be conducted on a handicap basis of 90% of 210.
3. Participants average for tournament will be based on the following order:
 - A. April 15, 2011 highest USBC sanctioned league average of 21 or more games.
 - B. 2011 Summer USBC sanctioned league average of 21 or more games.
 - League sheet needs to be submitted for verification by SCCUSBC.
 - C. January 1, 2012, USBC sanctioned league average of 21 or more games.
 - D. April 15, 2010 highest USBC sanctioned league average of 21 or more games.
 - E. If none of the above, Participant will use 210 average.

It is the participant's responsibility to verify accuracy of their average whether originally submitted by participant or others. Submission of a lower or false average could result in disqualification of the participant.
4. This tournament will enforce USBC rule 319 in its entirety. This includes reporting of previous tournament winnings and a 10 pin or more increase in average as of January 1, 2012 from April 15, 2011 or Summer 2011, USBC highest sanctioned league average or 21 or more games.
5. A replacement bowler will be allowed for paid entries. Replacements average will be based on rule 3.
6. Entry fee \$25.00 – Breakdown: Lineage \$9.75, Expense \$5.00, Prize fund \$10.25
No refunds of entry fees with less than 48 hour notice prior to 1/21/12 to the SCCUSBC.
7. All prize monies will be returned 100%. Prize ratio will be 1 in every 4 entries per division. Prize monies will be based on total pin fall plus handicap per division. All ties will be combined and prize money divided evenly.
8. Payment of prize monies won will be mailed no later than 30 days after the close of the tournament, except when USBC has authorized delay in payment, pending settlement of any claim or protest which affects tournament standings.
9. **Tournament date: 1/21/2012. Pre-Entries close: 1/16/2012. Check-in: 9:00 am. Start: 10:00am**
On-Site entries accepted at ***cash only entry fee of \$30.00***, first come, first serve based on lane availability.
10. Check in will start at 9:00am, Participants will need to show current 2011-2012 USBC membership card or copy, which can be obtained and printed from www.bowl.com.
11. The tournament officials shall have full power to act on any disputes or complaints. Any appeal or protest shall be made in writing with-in 72 hours per USBC tournament rule 329. Any rules not covered, shall be governed by the 2010-2012 USBC tournament rules and regulations.
