

Santa Clara County USBC Junior/Adult Fun Doubles Tournament

October 16, 2022 – 4th Street Bowl, 1441 N. Fourth Street, San Jose, CA 95112

Squad 1: Check-in at 9:00 am, starts at 10:00 am

Squad 2: Check-in 12:30 pm, starts at 1:30 pm

Format: Tournament will consist of a 3-game series: Games 1 & 2 will be regular. Game 3 will be 9-pin No Tap.

Tournament is open to all USBC Youth and Adult members in good standing. Bowlers must produce proof of membership by showing their USBC Membership card (or a copy) at check in. All Youth bowlers must not have reached their 18th birthday prior to August 1st, 2022.

- 1. Entering averages will be taken in this order:
 - A. 2021-22 USBC Composite average of 21 or more games from bowl.com
 - B. 2020-21 USBC Composite average of 21 or more games from bowl.com.
 - C. 2019-20 USBC Composite average of 21 or more games from bowl.com.
 - D. **YOUTH ONLY:** Current average of 15 games or more can be used if a current league sheet is provided.
 - E. If none of the above, the bowler will enter with a 230 average.

Note: If the bowler only carries a sport/challenge average, we will adjust the average to a regular average using the sport/challenge conversion chart.

- 2. **Handicap:** Handicapped at 90% for all divisions. Handicap will be 90% of 460 for doubles and 90% of 230 for any singles side events (brackets, side pots, etc).
- All averages should be verified before mailing. Full payment of all tournament fees must be included with entry form or entry will not be accepted and will be returned. Please make checks payable to SCCUSBC. Pre-Entries due by October 7, 2022. Walk-ins will be allowed based on lane availability.
- 4. **Forfeiture/Rerate**: Bowlers who enter with incorrect average may be subject to forfeiture of scholarship. Bowlers may be rerated or adjusted at the discretion of the tournament directors.
- 5. Youth bowlers can bowl both squads with a different adult partner.
- 6. **Age**: Tournament is open to ALL Youth bowlers who have not reached their 18th birthday prior to August 1, 2022
- 7. **Tournament Fees:** For Youth: Lineage \$12.00, Prize fund \$17.00, Expense: \$1.00 for a total of \$30.00. For Adult: Lineage \$15.00, Prize fund \$14.00, Expense: \$1.00 for a total of \$30.00. Total price is \$60.00 for the doubles team. All prize fund money for the doubles team will be going to the Youth in SMART scholarship funds.
- 8. Additional prize fund money will be added by SCCUSBC. All prize fund monies collected will be returned 100% to participants in the form of scholarships through the USBC SMART program and held in SMART account # 09738. Prize Fund Payout ratio will be at least one for each six (6) entries. For more information on the SMART program, please visit www.bowl.com.
- 9. Substitutions will be permitted only in the same line up position. All changes must be submitted to the tournament Officials prior to the squad start time.
- 10. All bowlers are to check in one (1) hour prior to start time and all bowlers are required to show USBC membership card (or copy) at check in.
- 11. All bowlers must be dressed in presentable attire. Since this is FUN tournament, T-shirts will be allowed if they don't have any profane saying/words and don't advertise anything bad. No Alcohol, tobacco, or profane advertising allowed on equipment, or in the bowler's area. Decisions on questionable attire will be made by the Tournament Officials and are final.
- 12. Tournament will be certified with USBC.

13. Divisions: Division 1 370 & above
Division 2 320 to 369
Division 3 319 & below

14. All rules not covered in the above shall be governed by USBC published rules at time of tournament. All decisions made by the Tournament Director are final.
