## 2025-26 9-Pin No Tap Singles Tournament Sunday, January 11, 2026

#### Tournament Rules: Please keep a copy of these rules for your use.

- 1. Tournament will consist of three games of 9-Pin No Tap Singles, by the following age divisions: Div. 1: 65 & over, Div. 2: 50 64, and Div. 3: 49 15
- 2. An entrant must be an adult member in good standing with the USBC. If not a member of SCCUSBC, the entrant must provide an average verification from either their local association or bowl.com.
- 3. Junior bowlers will be allowed to enter with a minimum age of 15 years old as of day of tournament.
- 4. The tournament shall be conducted on a handicap basis of 90% of 220.
- 5. Average must be 21 games or more and will be taken in this order:
  - a. **2024-25** USBC certified highest average of all USBC leagues bowled from bowl.com.
  - b. Current highest USBC certified average of 21 or more games as of December 29, 2025 (must provide a league sheet).
  - c. 2023-24 USBC certified highest average of all USBC leagues bowled from bowl.com.
  - d. If bowler has none of the above averages, bowler will bowl scratch with 220.
- 6. USBC Rule 319c (Average Adjustments Rerating) will be applied for current averages that are 20+ pins higher than last year's book. If the assigned average is not accepted by the bowler, the entry fee shall be refunded. Rules 319a2 and 319d will be waived.
- 7. It is the bowler's responsibility to verify the accuracy of their average whether originally submitted by the bowler or others. Failure to use the correct average may result in disqualification of the bowler's scores. Refer to Rules 5 and 6.
- 8. A substitute bowler will be allowed for paid entries. Substitutes' averages subject to rule 5, 6, and 7.
- 9. Entry fee breakdown: Lineage \$16.50, Expenses \$1.75, Prize fund \$21.75 for a total of \$40.00. **No refunds without notification to tournament management prior to the start of the squad**.
- 10. All prize monies will be returned 100%. Prize ratio will be at least one prize for each 6 entries per division. Prize monies will be based on total pins plus handicap per division. All ties will be combined, and prize money divided evenly. Junior bowlers who are in the Prize Fund List will be paid in the form of scholarships through the USBC SMART program and held in SMART account #9738.
- 11. Multiple participation is allowed at this tournament bowlers will cash with their highest series only. Bowlers may pre-register for more than one squad if they choose.
- 12. Tournament squads may be canceled or combined based on bowler participation.
- 13. Check-in is 60 minutes (1 hour) before scheduled time to bowl, and each bowler must check themselves in. Any bowler not checked in 15 minutes prior to the squad may lose their spot and the entry fee will not be refunded.
- 14. Walk-ins and re-entries are allowed based on lane availability but must sign up no less than 30 minutes prior to the start of the squad.
- 15. All prize money won will be mailed (or delivered) to the individual bowler within thirty (30) days after the close of the tournament. An exception exists when USBC has authorized delay in payment pending settlement of any claim or protest which affects position standing. Checks will be mailed to the USBC membership card address on file.
- 16. Any rules not covered shall be governed by the 2025-26 USBC tournament rules and regulations.
