

CA STATE BVL QUALIFYING INFORMATION AND RULES

The California State USBC Association will host the Helen Duval Veterans Tournament (also known as the State BVL Event). The top BVL Qualifier in each division of our BVL Charity Event will have the option of representing our association at this tournament. The tournament will be held in March 2019 in Stockton, CA and there will be 2 squad times available to choose from.

Please note that although we are running our qualifying as a three game no-tap series, the State BVL tournament is a scratch tournament – you will be bowling three games scratch within your average division.

1. BOWLERS WILL BOWL IN THE FOLLOWING DIVISIONS:

ADULTS (WOMEN/MEN)

CLASSIC – 201 AND OVER

DIV A – 185 TO 200

DIV B – 170 TO 184

DIV C – 155 TO 169

DIV D – 140 TO 154

DIV E – 139 AND UNDER

YOUTH (GIRLS/BOYS)

CLASSIC – 201 AND OVER

DIV A – 180 TO 200

DIV B – 155 TO 179

DIV C – 130 TO 154

DIV D – 105 TO 129

DIV E – 104 AND UNDER

2. There will be separate divisions by gender: Adults are separated into Women and Men, Youth are separated into Girls and Boys.

3. AVERAGE RULES: Averages will be taken in this order:

- a. Winter 2017-18 OR Summer 2018 USBC certified league average of 21 or more games, whichever is HIGHEST
- b. Current highest USBC certified league average of 21 or more games (must provide a league sheet) as of December 1, 2018.

4. **Bowlers are responsible for verifying their own average.** If the submitted average is incorrect, the score may be disqualified.

5. All qualifiers MUST be a member of the Santa Clara County USBC (SCCUSBC).

Bowlers who are part of another association can purchase a local membership for \$10 in order to qualify.

6. Any tie scores for the top spot in a division will be resolved as follows: The bowler with the most pins bowled over average for the 3 game series will be declared the winner of that division.

7. If the top qualifier in a division is not available to go to the state BVL event, the next qualifier in line will be contacted and offered the spot.
